This instruction is designed to clarify elementary Christian doctrine and teach the basic skills of discipleship and spiritual discipline, which include...

- Bible study
- Prayer
- Worship
- Witness
- Service
- Community
- Family Living
- Leadership

Requirements are:

- Memory—assigned Bible passages
- Journal—notes of readings and class work in a Composition Notebook (provided)
- Classwork—homework, essays, quizzes, tests
- Participation—prepared, meaningful participation in classroom discussions

Please keep up. My intention is that everyone learns these basic Christian doctrines. I will not leave you behind, but you must also put in the time and effort.

Requirements:

- Summarize 20 of the pastor's sermons
- Pass the 11 tests on the Confirmation Guide
- Engage in an oral examination with the Pastor prior to the May confirmation ceremony at the end of eighth grade
- Faithfully attend all weekly classes, and make up those missed—missing more than four jeopardizes your completing that year's classes
- Memorize the Bible passages assigned
- Participate meaningfully in the life of the church, such as:
 - Acolyte (everybody must do this)
 - youth group
 - assisting with Sunday school
 - assisting with VBS
 - participate in Advent or Lent soup supper
 - participate in the choir or bell choir
 - participate in the worship service
